

Sherman I.S.D. Attendance Zone Information

Given current policy considerations

The development of the Sherman I.S.D. attendance zones has been a goal-driven process. The goals include: 1) maintaining neighborhood schools; 2) removing portable classrooms; and 3) allowing for future growth at each campus.

- Approximately 950 students will attend a different elementary school, including 470 at Neblett and 450 at Sory.
- Five of our six current elementary schools are rated as Recognized schools by the state of Texas and the sixth school was rated as Recognized the previous year.
- Maps detailing elementary attendance zones are displayed in the library at each SISD campus and the central administration building as well as the SISD website. At www.shermanisd.net, you may click on “Attendance Zone Map”, then click on “Sherman I.S.D. Elementary Attendance Zone Map”. You can then enlarge the map to see more detailed information.
- In April a letter will go out to all current elementary parents with campus assignment information.
