



The following is an example of health care expenses under Section 213 of the IRC

Acupuncture - Performed by a licensed practitioner

Alcoholism or Drug Dependency - PYT. To a treatment center

Ambulance

Birth Control - pills, spermicidal foams, condoms

Car Controls - Special controls for the handicapped

Chiropractors - Services within the scope of license

Contact Lenses

Co-Payments - Balances not paid by other health insurance

Crutches - Purchase or Rental

Deductibles and Co-Insurance - Balanced not paid by health insurance

Dental Fees - X-Rays, fillings, braces, extractions, treatments, etc.

Doctor's Fee / Excess Charges - Charges not paid by other health insurance

Eyeglasses - Lenses, frames, examinations

Fertility Treatments

Guide Dog - Purchase of blind or deaf

Halfway House

Health Care Equipment - not of general use articles

Hearing Aids

Hospitalization - including private room coverage

Hypnosis - for treatment of illness

Laboratory Fees

LASIK eye surgery

Learning Disability - tutoring by licensed school or therapist

Long-Term Care premiums - with amount limits depending on age

Massages - if Prescribed to treat a medical condition

Medical Services

Medicines - Payment for Prescribed drugs (Rx)

Medicines - Over the counter (i.e. viagra, advil, allergy medicine, antacids, visine, nasal sprays, calamine lotion, cough drops, bactine, alcohol, cold medicines, laxatives, first-aid creams, reading glasses, contact lens cleaning solution, carpal-tunnel wrist supports)

Medicines - Dual purpose Over the Counter if accompanied with Drs. note for a specific medical condition (i.e. prenatal vitamins, acne treatment-Retin A, hormone therapy, St John's Wort for depression, orthopedic shoes & inserts, weight-loss drugs)

Nursing Home - confinement for treatment of illness or injury

Nursing Services

Optometrist

Oxygen - if medically necessary

Psychologist

Psychotherapy Schools - special schooling to relieve handicap

Smoke Ender Programs - if prescribed by a Dr. for a specific medical diagnosis

Surgery

Syringes, Needles, and Injections

Telephone - Special for the deaf

Television - Audio display for the deaf

Therapy - Physical or Occupational

Transplants

Tuition Fee - Charges for medical care included in the tuition fee of a college

Wheelchairs

X-Ray Fees
