

RIDING THE SCHOOL BUS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I ride the bus on the first day of school?

Yes, If you live at least two miles from your school.

How do I register to ride the bus?

You will receive information from your school to be returned and signed.

You will also receive a card from the driver at a later date.

Can I bring my band instrument on the bus?

Yes. Band instruments are allowed if they may be held in the lap, fit under the seat, or in the interior storage rack. Large instruments should be transported by private vehicle.

What if I am a Pre-K, Head Start, or Special Needs student?

Transportation will be arranged through the campus office.

What if I move to a new address?

Please notify your school if you move or change addresses. If you no longer require transportation, please notify the Transportation Office at 903-891-6433.

May I bring a friend on the bus or ride to a different stop other than the assigned stop?

No. Unless prior special permission has written approval by the campus principal or assistant principal, students will not be admitted or discharged at unauthorized locations

Are cell phones allowed on buses?

Yes. Students may use cell phones only to the extent that student code of conduct policies and safety distractions are not violated

Do buses wait or sound their horn at bustops?

No. Students are required to be at the bustop prior to the arrival of the bus. Students should avoid running after buses due to being late at the stop.

Do buses return to stops if a student missed the bus?

No. Buses must stay on schedule

How do I get information or assistance?

Students should feel free to discuss questions with their driver. Parents may contact the campus administrators for student concerns or the Transportation Office for other general questions.
