Schedule & Class Times: Summer School classes will be in session on Mondays through Thursdays. High School Summer School times for Acceleration Courses will be from 8:00am-11:30am and 12:30pm – 4:00pm for 15 days each session. For Credit Recovery courses, class times will be 8:00am – 4pm for the full four weeks. The school will be open from 7:30am until 4:00pm for extended classes and intervention. Students who are enrolled in both summer school sessions are required to remain on campus and in the cafeteria during lunch.

Course Offerings: SHS Acceleration offerings will be based on demand and actual student enrollment. For Acceleration, we will offer the following classes during both 1st and 2nd session: Government, Economics, and Art I. For Credit Recovery, we will offer all Core Courses plus Spanish I and II via our Online Credit Recovery System, Plato. Some Electives are available on an as needed basis.

Support Services: **School bus transportation is provided upon request. Free Breakfast and Lunch will be available from June 5th – June 28th.** Free Breakfast is available at 7:30am and must be consumed in the cafeteria before going to class. Free Lunch is also available to the students once they are dismissed from class for the day. Students may purchase soft drinks and snacks from vending machines on their breaks.

Acceleration Credits: For the Acceleration Courses, students must meet the State's requirement of 90% attendance. Students can only miss 2 days. If a third day is missed, the student is not eligible to receive credit and will be withdrawn from the course without refund of tuition. In addition, tardies can accumulate into absences. A tardy of 15 minutes or less counts as 1 tardy. A tardy of 16-45 minutes counts as 2 tardies. A tardy of 46 or more minutes counts as 3 tardies. An accumulation of 6 tardies will count as 1 absence. And remember, a student can only have 2 absences. Make plans to be here and be on time.

Credit Recovery Credits: Students who are working under the Credit Recovery system will receive direct teaching and online instruction, and may finish their course quicker by also working while away from school (All Mastery work has to be done at school under the teacher's supervision). Once students earn their passing grade, they are excused from further attendance for that course. If students have another course they need to repeat, they will start the next online course as determined by the Summer School Director. Students will have 4 weeks to complete as many courses as they need to, all for one flat tuition fee.

Tuition: The tuition rates for Acceleration Courses will be \$50 per 4-week Summer School Session. Tuition rates for Credit Recovery will be \$50 per 4-week Summer School Session. SISD students who receive free or reduced lunch should see their school counselor for available tuition options. Out-of-district rates will be \$150 per Acceleration Course (semester = 1 course) or \$150 per 4-week Summer School Session of Credit Recovery access.
