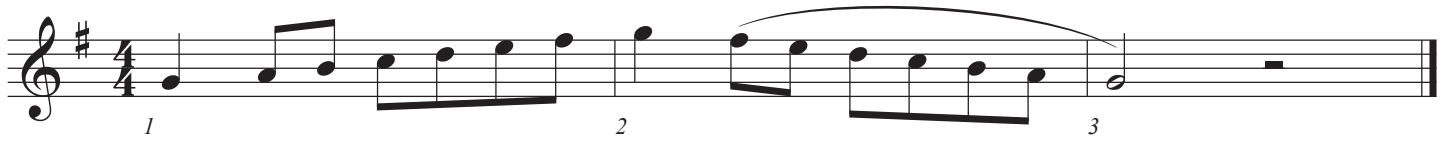

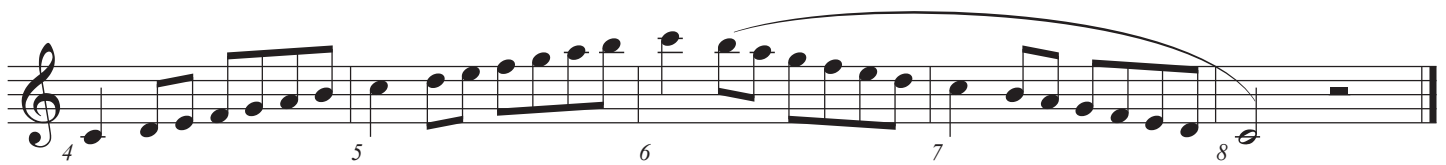

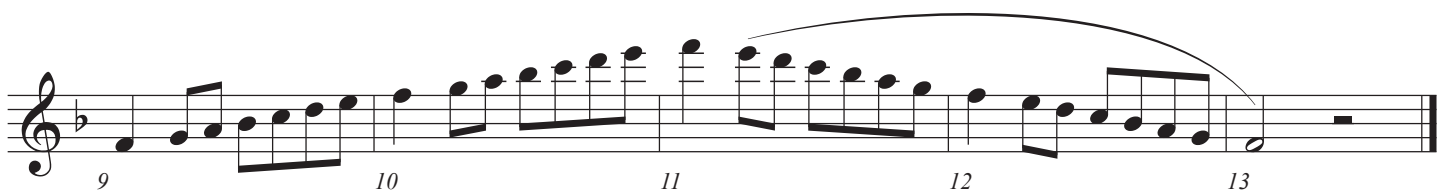
Chant: Concert F, Tenor Sax G; 1 sharp, F#



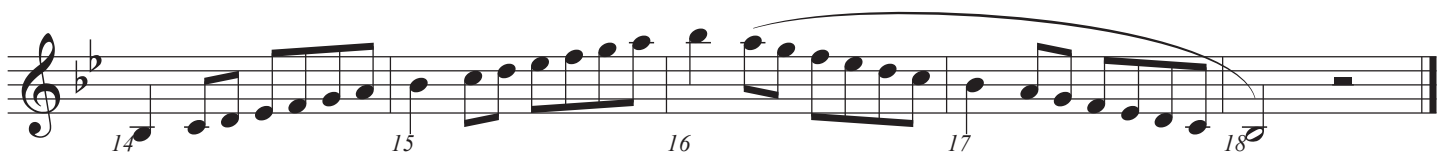
Chant: Concert Bb, Tenor Sax C; No sharps, No flats
