

SHAC Minutes 12/12/17

The Sherman ISD School Health Advisory Council met on December 12, 2017 to discuss two agenda items primarily. The first was to discuss recent legislation that districts must provide information to students about e-cigarette prevention. The CATCH My Breath Youth E-Cigarette Prevention Program was chosen because of its connection to the CATCH program and its free cost for the year.

The next agenda item discussed was the implementation of a school garden at Sherman High School. Three members of the group have an appointment to discuss this with the high school principal this week and will keep the group informed as developments happen.
