

Minutes from SHAC Meeting on September 18, 2014

Since this was the first meeting of the new year, members introduced themselves. Judy Hathcock gave the members a brief background of the purpose of SHAC. The "Let's Move Sherman" annual food service sponsored fair that will be held on October 21st was discussed. SHAC will sponsor a booth where parents can get more information about the group. Two members volunteered to help out with the fair. Shannon Pratt volunteered to be the parent co-chair of the group.

Information about six human sexuality programs was distributed to the members. The group will be choosing a program to be implemented at the seventh grade level at Piner Middle School. Discussion was held about integrating information about basic biological changes for students in grades 4 and 5 with a graduated human sexuality program for students in grades 6 through 8. General information could be shared with students at lower grade levels with more age appropriate information given to students at higher grade levels. Principals will be polled at campuses that serve grades 4 and 5 to see what is currently being done in this area. At the next meeting on October 2nd, the council will be voting on the program that will be recommended to be implemented at seventh grade.
